High Altitude Health Tips

- · Reduce alcohol, caffeine & salty foods.
- Drink 3-4 times more water than usual.
- · Get plenty of rest before & during your stay.
- Take it easy! Your heart is working harder at this altitude, so quit while you're ahead if you're tired.
- Wear sunscreen—you receive 30% more ultraviolet radiation up here than at sea level!
- Wear sunglasses with ultraviolet protection, even on cloudy or snowy days. Your eyes can actually get "snow burned."
- Eat high carbohydrate meals, limiting fat & protein, for the first few days at altitude.
- In winter, keep warm & dry, & be sure clothes are not too tight or cutting off your circulation. Layering is best.

SYMPTOMS of High Altitude Sickness:

Headache Nausea Unusual tiredness Trouble sleeping

High altitude sickness symptoms usually go away in a day or two, but if you develop a worsening cough or feel like you have fluid in your lungs—see a doctor immediately!




